# ASSAM & ARUNACHAL PRADESH

# GUWAHATI-KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK-DIRANG-TAWANG-BUMLA PASS-BOMDILA-GUWAHATI





**Day 1:** Guwahati to Kaziranga: 220 KM (Travel Time 5 to 6 Hrs)

Arrival in Guwahati Airport/Railway Station, received by our representative and drive to Kaziranga National Park, enroute visit Maha Mrityunjay Temple- It is world largest Shivalinga, at the height of 126 ft. On arrival check in at your hotel/resort. Overnight leisure and stay relax at **KAZIRANGA**. (Subject to arrival in Guwahati within 12:00 PM)



Day 2: Kaziranga National Park Jungle Safari

### (Declared UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE IN 1985)

After breakfast you will be going to explore the central range of the park. 8:30 AM Your Jeep will take you in the designated route where you can enjoy the animal sighting, common sightings are One Horned Rhinoceros, Wild Water Buffalo, Indian Baison,

Elephant, Swamp Deer, Hog Deer, Sambar Deer, Wild Boar, Assam Macaque, Bengal Tiger, Golden Tiger, Indian Grey Mongoose, Chinese Pangolin, Western Hoolock Gibbon Etc. For bird lovers this park will be a birding paradise and commonly you can sight Crested Serpent Eagle, Palla's Eagle, Grey Headed Fishing Eagle, Greater Adjutant Stork, Bar Headed Geese, Whistling Teal, Pelicans, Bengal Florican, Cormorants etc. (Best Season for birding tour-November to February).

Safari will end after 2 hours and then the jeep will drop you in your hotel, after freshen up you can visit -Orchid Park, The Orchid Park boasts of having more than 500 varieties of wild orchids, 132 species of sour fruits and leafy vegetables, 46 species of bamboo, 12 species of cane and many other plants along with various species of local fishes. You can enjoy an ethnic lunch prepared by local community people work in the park.

**Day 3**: Kaziranga to Dirang 4910 Ft. 251 KM (Travel Time 6 Hours) Today **Elephant Safari** is optional and subject to availability, timings are: 5:15 AM to 6:15 AM, 6:15 AM to 7:15 AM. After early breakfast check out from your hotel/resort and start drive by 9:00 AM ahead to Arunachal Pradesh, on the border out post at Bhalookpong, get the immigration process done and enter in the

Kameng District, enroute mountains of the region and drive along with the Kameng River. Enroute you can visit Tippi Orchidarium (Optional), on arrival check in at your homestay/hotel/resort. Overnight at **DIRANG/SANGTI VALLEY** 

(Optional Stay-You can visit Sangti Valley further 30 mins drive from Dirang) is a beautiful valley situated in the bank of Sangti River and surrounded by the valleys is one of the beautiful destinations to spend some quality time with nature and without mobile network.

Sightseeing options: Mandala Top, Thupsung Dhargve Buddhist Monastery, Dirang Dzong

**Day 4:** Dirang to Tawang 140 KM 11500 Ft. (Travel Time 5 Hours) Today after breakfast you will drive to Tawang enroute visit Sela Pass (**Sela Lake**), Jaswantgarh (War Memorial) and Jang Waterfall, on arrival at Tawang check in at your hotel, and evening drive to Army war memorial to see the light & sound show organised by

Indian Army to showcase the real picture of Chinese aggression in 1962 War.

Overnight leisure and stay relax at Hotel in **TAWANG**.



Day 5: Bumla Pass 15200 Ft.

Today after breakfast you will be driving to **Bumla Pass** which is one of the major highlights of the tour as it shares the border between China's Tsona County in **Tibet** and **TAWANG** District of Arunachal Pradesh of India. As Bumla Pass is situated in the

highest altitude of Himalayan Range makes the area covered with snow throughout the year, sightseeing visit PTSO lake, Madhuri Lake and meet & greet with Indian Army guarding over the post. (Visit are subject to the permission from Army & Weather Condition), Post lunch visit the India's largest **Buddhist Monastery** and the giant **Buddha Statue** standing in the middle of the town as a landmark of **MONPA TRIBE** of Arunachal Pradesh.

**Please note: TAWANG** is still in its basic standard and as being situated very far from mainland please do consider with the service standard and sometime because of load shading nights voltage goes down, please praise the beauty of our mother nature and forgive us in case of any such issue, although we try our best to give the best out of possible.

Day 6: Tawang to Bomdila 180KM 7253 Ft. (Travel Time 5 Hours)

Today after breakfast you will drive to Bomdila which is a headquarter of West Kameng district on arrival check in at your hotel and if time permits then visit Bomdila Monastery or Bomdila view point.

Overnight leisure and stay relax at Hotel in **BOMDILA** 



# Day 7: Bomdila to Guwahati 260 KM (Travel Time 7 Hours)

Today after early breakfast you will drive to Guwahati, on arrival check in at your hotel/resort and if time permits visit Brahmaputra Heritage Museum, Rope Way & River Side Park. You can also avail the most popular river cruise in Guwahati- (ALFRESCO GRAND) to

enjoy Sunset Cruise/Sundown Cruise/ Dinner Cruise at night which includes cultural programs onboard. Advance booking is mandatory to avoid last minute rush.

# Day 8: Guwahati - Kamakhya Temple Darshan

Today early morning drive to Nilachal Hills situated in the heart of the city to visit the famous oldest and most revered Shakti Peeth of tantric practices. Visit the temple at wee hours to avoid the rush in common line and in case of emergency avail VIP Pass on additional

cost to save your time. Post lunch our driver will drop you at Airport/Railway Station.

# SAVE PLANT, SAVE NATURE

**DID YOU KNOW?** There are around 400,000 plants species recorded in the world and many more waiting to be discovered and named. Yet although the threat to the existence of many wild animals is now widely recognized, not many people are aware that plants are also in danger. In February 2015, the Centre of Biological Diversity stated "Of the more than 300,000 known species of plants, the IUCN has evaluated only 12914 species, finding about 68% of evaluated plant are threatened with extinction.
